








OU6 Planned Sites

Ashcroft Rear (Expanded from app.1,500yds to 4,500yds ~ 270 trucks)





DOT ROW along Ferry BLVD

app.1,000yds or about 60 trucks



Vacant Lot Behind Blue Goose

- $\sim 4,400 \text{ yds} = 400 \text{ trucks}$
- ~ 660 yds = 60 trucks PHC waste
- Fall/Winter of 2021
- About 12 weeks to complete
- Will host a public meeting for the residents of Willow and a portion of Housatonic Ave

Beacon Point



- ~ 2,400 yds = 200 trucks
- ~ 250 yds = 20 trucks PHC waste
- Trying to gain access to private property
- Fall/Winter 2021
- About 10 weeks to complete


Wooster Park



- Estimate = 1,500yds
- Waste area much larger
 5,000 yds but still
 chasing the end
- Fall 2021
- About 12 weeks to complete
- First neighborhood public meeting was held on May 12th
- Second meeting to be held

OU4 Ballfield Work Completed or Ongoing Since April






- Approximately 4,000 CY consolidated, compacted and covered.
- Posi-Shell cover applied on all previously imported Raymark Waste at OU4 Ballfield
- OU4 site and cap design ongoing
- Stormwater control and conveyance system design complete
- 5 perimeter air monitors at OU4 and 2 at East Main Street are operating daily

OU4 Containment Structure










- Temporary Fabric Structure (TFS)
- Approx. Dimensions (I x w x h): 100' x 130' x 40'
- Used primarily for material additives and dewatering
- Closed system with air treatment
- Aluminum structural frame with PVC coated fabric membrane

OU4 Stormwater System





New Pump Station

- 4 Axial Flow Pumps
- 200 CFS Capacity
- Operates during significant storm and high-water events
- Masonry Pumphouse



Air Monitoring

OU4 - Air Monitoring Results

- Since 4/28/21 public meeting Daily Average Dust = 0.001 to 0.010 mg/m³
- No exceedances of the OU4 Dust Action Level criteria (0.014 mg/m³)
- All five dust meters and sample collection systems in operation
- One personnel chemical sample collection system
- No exceedances of chemical health and safety criteria

OU6 - Air Monitoring Results

- Site Restoration at 250 and 304/340 East Main Street Properties
- No Raymark Waste handling conducted

Perimeter Air Monitoring Updates - OU4 and OU6 Restoration

- All imported clean soil tested every 500-1000 cy to verify meets CT Residential Soil Criteria
- Only during site restoration Dust Action Level raised to 0.150 mg/m³
- Same Dust Action Levels used during
 Contract Plating and Haul Road construction
