

Guidelines for Culling Oysters and Planting Shell

- 1) Plant shells in areas where you are catching oysters or have caught oysters in the past.
- 2) Do not waste shell on questionable bottom, a secret creek or hiding spot or in the deepest portion of the navigational channel.
- 3) Do not tie to a float, pile, pier, dock or mooring belonging to any of the marinas or yacht clubs in the river. Over time you will leave a large mound of shells that does not help anybody.
- 4) Do not place shells where they will be exposed between high and low tide.
