- Locate and test your smoke detectors;
- Test the hot water temperature in your home at your kitchen sink:
- Identify that residence address markers are clearly visible.

- Smoke Detectors need to be present on every level of your home. Change the batteries in your smoke detectors in the spring and fall. Smoke detectors save lives!
- Hot water temperatures in your home should not exceed 120°F. Serious burns can occur, especially to the young and elderly. Lowering the temperature on your hot water tank can prevent burns and reduce your energy costs.
- The address on your home should be clearly marked so, in the case of an emergency, we can identify your home safely and quickly.
