

The Baldwin Center Inclement Weather Policy

When the Stratford Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather, The Baldwin Center activities, including classes, clubs, lunch and transportation to The Baldwin Center are cancelled. Cancellation or delay of transportation services to medical appointments and grocery shopping on these days is determined by staff. The Baldwin Center is open for non-structured activities such as billiards, board games and cards. Staff report to The Baldwin Center during their regularly scheduled hours.

When the Stratford Public Schools have a delayed opening, The Baldwin Center activities including classes, clubs and transportation to The Baldwin Center prior to 11:00 am are cancelled. Activities and transportation to The Baldwin Center will resume at 11:00 am and lunch will be served at 11:45 am. Please note that instructor-led classes scheduled to start at, or after, 11:00 am may be cancelled if the instructor is unable to get to the Baldwin Center. A “make-up” class will be scheduled for any class that requires advanced payment and is cancelled due to inclement weather or instructor absence. Call The Baldwin Center if you are unsure if your class will take place.

When Town of Stratford municipal buildings are closed, have a delayed opening or an early closing, The Baldwin Center will do the same.

If travel becomes hazardous during the day, bus passengers will be transported home. No passenger will be left stranded.

Baldwin Center closings and delays will be publicized on News Channel 12 and their website connecticut.news12.com, WFSB Channel 3 and their website www.wfsb.com, WICC radio, and will be posted on the Baldwin Center’s website at www.stratfordct.gov/seniorservices.
