Safe Boating Certificate or greater certification Hold a valid drivers license Pass a drug test Pass a background check Be able to swim Be able to display safe operation of the pump-out boat. CPR or basic first aid training is preferred Display proper use of a VHF radio. Possess document and record keeping skills Conduct him/herself in a professional manner
Responsibilities-	Under the direction of the pump-out Liaison . Direct subordinates in the operation of the pump-out boat in accordance with the directives and policies set forth by the WHMC and the Pump-out Liaison including but not limited to: purchase of protective equipment, collecting, tallying and submitting payroll, providing training when required, tallying daily and weekly pump-out sheets, assigning of tasks, development of employee scheduling, maintaining employee files, and providing discipline for minor infractions as needed. In addition to the above, the Pump-out Supervisor shall serve as a regular member of the crew responsible for: Operating the pump-out vessel in a safe manner, performing daily checks, performing basic record keeping of the pump log and vessel log, performing basic vessel maintenance as directed and communicating with the appropriate members of the organizational structure when necessary.
