Permission is hereby granted to do the following work under the control and direction of the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Highway Operations at the location designated hereon, subject to the statements made on the application for permit, and to the pertinent provisions of the current Highway Encroachment Permit Regulations manual, including amendments thereto.

This permit does not become effective until all necessary local and State licenses and permits are obtained by the Permittee or designated agent, and further the Permittee shall be subject to all Federal, State and local regulations.

This permit is issued in strict compliance with, but not limited by, the following specific requirements, referenced attachments, and the current edition of Department of Transportation's Standard Specifications for Roads, Bridges and Incidental Construction as applicable.

The Department of Transportation Permit Inspector, Dan DiRienzo (860) 597-4768, **MUST BE NOTIFIED AND THE CALL BEFORE YOU DIG REQUEST NUMBER RECORDED 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF STARTING WORK ON THE PROJECT.** REQUEST NO. \_\_\_\_\_

Excavate to modify and tie into the existing drainage system, remove the remaining pavement on the west side of the project area at the property line, install 975' of chain link fence (Black/Green) and do related work within the highway right-of-way in accordance with the application received 09/09/13.

- The hours of operation for this encroachment permit are: 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM exclusively. All required work to include set up and break down, shall be performed between the hours noted above. The roadway shall be restored and completely open to traffic by the ending time noted above.
- All pavement shall be saw cut. For longitudinal curbing replacement, cut a minimum of 18" from the face of curb. The slurry from the saw cutting must not be allowed to enter the state's drainage system and is required to be cleaned up immediately to prevent tracking.
- All areas disturbed as a result of this operation shall be restored to the equivalency of their original condition. Disturbed earth areas shall be loamed, seeded and stabilized.
- All vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be adequately protected through the use of appropriate traffic control patterns. Uniformed police officers or personnel, who are certified for traffic control to a level equivalent to the National Safety Council certification, shall be employed to direct traffic through the work area.
- Requirements of the permit are subject to change as field conditions warrant. Any changes will require a review and approval by the field inspector.
- PERMANENT TRENCH RESTORATION MUST BE COMPLETED WITHIN 60 DAYS OF COMMENCEMENT WORK.
- Hot Mix Asphalt - Super Pave (HMAS) material shall be used on all temporary and permanent road excavation repairs.

The Permit Inspector must be notified upon completion of work for final inspection and approval.




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8. Pavement replacement shall be with an approved bituminous concrete mix consisting of 6" of Hot Mix Asphalt Super-pave (HMAS) Level 2, 1.0 in two lifts and 3" of HMAS Level 2, .5 also in two lifts. A tack coat and sealer shall be used when permanent pavement is place.

9. The permittee is responsible to inspect and maintain temporary pavement and pavement markings until the permanent restoration is completed.

10. The Department of Transportation will secure a Drainage Connection Concurrence for the owner's signature that must be recorded in the town land records. A certified copy of the recording shall be forwarded to the District Drainage Engineer, Mr. Neil Creem at 140 Pond Lily Avenue, New Haven, Ct 06515,

The permit inspector must be notified upon completion of work for final inspection and approval.
